



The solo 'One Moment' deals with memory and grief and is a taster from the dance theatre performance by Rumiko Otsuka called 'Death and life of Mr O' premiered on 17th September at INKONST, Malmö. Mr O is a stereotypical Japanese salaryman who works tirelessly during an era of economic growth (the 1960s-1980s), even sacrificing his own family life. The solo expresses the sadness, struggle and confusion of a 'Salaryman' who lost his daughter and tried to live his everyday life, almost like a robot; an intimate glimpse into a rapidly changing Japanese culture reveals who he really was.
